Sub: Floral Inventorization and other related works in Susunia and Jhalda MPCAs in South Bengal

Dear Sir,

With reference to the subject mentioned above and the meeting held at your chamber on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2018, we wish to carry out the floral inventorization and other related works for Susunia MPCA in Bankura district and Jhalda MPCA in Purulia district with assistance from your department. The PIA of the project is Research Circle, Directorate of Forests, Government of West Bengal. The total approved budget for the assignment is Rs. 10.10 lakhs.

While conducting the floral inventorization in 2 MPCAs, the following works need to be carried out as per associated terms and conditions:

a) The floristic inventorization will be carried out in 200 ha. for each MPCA. The total area will be divided in 50 numbers of grid (unit size 200 x 200 meter) from which 5 grids will be randomly selected for the survey/floral inventorization. In each working grid 5 quadrates/sample plots will be laid out within a unit size of 20m x 20m for enumeration of trees. Inside each 20m x 20m quadrate 4 (four) plots of 5m x 5m and 5 (five) plots of 1m x 1m will be laid out for enumeration of shrubs and herbs/climbers respectively.

The inventorization need to be carried out in 3 (three) seasons i.e. Pre-monsoon (April), Postmonsoon (August) and Winter (December) for each MPCA during the project period by making a total of 3 visits in each MPCA. However, if situation demands or any other requirement arrives then another visit may be carried out to fill the data gap.

- b) The estimation of growing stock will be done by measuring the girth and height of individual trees in each 20m x 20m quadrates/sample plots for one time only during the project period.
- Biodiversity assessment: The detailed survey data in respect of trees, herbs, shrubs and c) climbers will be analyzed by as per existing biodiversity assessment formula. The following results/outputs needs to be emphasized:
  - **Population density** i.
  - ii. Sp. density & frequency
  - iii. Variation of species
  - **Species dominance** iv.
  - Status of new recruits v.
  - **Complete list of climbers & lianas** vi.
  - vii. Complete list of orchids and epiphytes

- d) List of Rare, Endangered & Threatened species and complete list of medicinal plants found in the MPCA areas.
- e) In all cases grid wise raw data need to be submitted along with analysis and result separately.
- f) Preparation of herbarium including its digitization of all medicinally important herbs and shrubs and needs to be handed over to us. However, only 1 set of herbarium needs to be prepared for each species for each MPCA.
- g) Submission of progress and final report along with geo tagging of field photographs of various event/activities in respect of all MPCAs. No publication can be made out of the study without taking written consent from us.
- h) For conducting floral inventorization work and other related activities a remuneration of Rs.
   6,000/- will be paid per 20m x 20m sample plot enumeration in each season of the 2 MPCAs (6000x25x3x2). Thus a total amount of Rs. 9,00,000/- will be paid for the work.
- i) An additional amount of Rs. 1,10,000/- will be paid for survey & demarcation with GPS of the MPCA area and laying out of grids & sample plots within the MPCA area.
- j) The amount mentioned above will be subjected to fund availability and time to time sanction by the Directorate Forest, Govt. of West Bengal.
- k) All the expenditures (related bills, vouchers and other related documents) should be submitted to the undersigned and are subjected to Audit by Govt. Auditor or CAG empanelled chattered accountant.
- Expenditure for transportation, food and lodging will be borne from your end. However we will facilitate to arrange vehicle, food, lodging and other logistic support.

While asking for the release of the installment it may be ensured that the amount for the pay and allowances of the staff who are actually in position is included. The unspent balance available from previous year should be intimated. This will be adjusted against the current year's grant.

2. A separate account for the grant received and expenditure incurred shall be maintained. The account will be subjected to audit by the authorized auditors of the Institutions. In case, facilities are not available for such auditing, the account will be audited by the Council's own internal auditors. 4. The grant will not be regarded as a subvention, towards the normal work of the Institution but should be exclusively utilized for the Research activity for which it has been sanctioned.

5. Expenditure should on no account exceed the allotment sanctioned for the enquiry. Expenditure incurred over and above the sanctioned amount against one or more subheads of expenditure such as pay allowances, contingencies, etc. shall be met without reference to the ICMR by re-appropriation of savings under remaining sub-heads provided that the total expenditure incurred during the financial year. 22. The Institute will maintain a **separate saving bank account** of the receipts and the expenditure incurred on the research scheme and will furnish a utilization certificate and an audited statement of the account pertaining to the grant.



7. While providing operational flexibility among various subheads under head Recurring-II, it should be ensured that not more than Rs. 1.5 lakh each should be spent for travel and contingency.
