
Mode: The most frequent ratings of student feedback (for the respective question no) — that is, the ratings that occurs the highest number of times.





Graphical Representation of Teachers' Feedback






































FEEDBACK FROM ALUMNI (2022-2023)







Graphical Representation of Alumni Feedback

















































Suggestion about the Syllabus or any other issue
