Folk-craft Exhibition-cum-Sale Report

On the eve of "Celebration of 75 years of Indian Independence" Vidyasagar University organized a three day Folk-craft Exhibition-cum-Sale from 19th to 21st April, 2022 at Ravishankar Hall inside the University premise. This programme was organized and supervised by Art and Literature Committee of Vidyasagar University. The university authority and especially the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor always provided their positive supports to the committee to organize this kind of programme. The objective of this programme was to encourage the folk artisan and also to promote their crafts from local to global. From different parts of our state, artisans came to join this programme with their aesthetic crafts. Gouranga Karmakar, a Dokra artist came from Guskara, East Burdwan in this exhibition. Prasanta Foujdar came from Bishnupur, Bankura with a almost extinct craft named, Dasavatar Tas, i.e., painting of Dasavatar of Lord Vishnu on a special paper. Angurbala Jana brought Gayna Bari, a special food made of lentils which is exclusively found in the rural settings of Bengal; she came from Paschim Medinipur to participate in this programme. She has also brought hand-made brass metal ornaments with her.

Bhim Sutradhar, a Chou Mask artist came from Charida village of Purulia with a mesmerizing collection of masks. Bhutnath Kumbhakar came from Panchmura, Bankura with a decade old folk art of Bengal namely Terracotta.

Another craft Madur which is exclusively found in Bengal had been brought by Ambika Das from Sabang, Paschim Medinipur. Akhilam Bibi came from Burdwan with another beautiful art of Bengal, i.e., Kantha Stitch which is basically hand-woven design on garments mostly by women.

Our state is also famous for its beautiful tribal crafts globally and the crafts made of Sabai grass is one of those crafts made by Sabar tribal community. Bishnu Sabar and Manoranjan Sabar came from Purulia with their hand-made baskets, trays, costers, mats, etc. made of Sabai grass.

All these artisans expressed their happiness to participate in this programme. They also expressed their gratitude to the Honorable Vice-Chancellor Professor Sibaji Pratim Basu, Professor Monanjali Bandyopadhyay, Chairperson, Art and Literature Committee and Professor Sumahan Bandyopadhyay, Convenor, Art and Literature Committee for their efforts to organize this programme successfully.

Pata (Scroll-painting) Exhibition-cum-sale was organised by the Art and Literature Committee of the Vidyasagar University, Paschim Medinipur. The exhibition was held during three days (5th-7th of April, 2022) into the hall namely Ravishankar Bhaban situated inside the University campus. This programme was a part of the set of three conjugated programmes organised by the Art and Literature Committee in celebration of 75 years of Indian Independence. The other two programmes in the set are (i) Folk-crafts Exhibition-cum-sale and (ii) Literary Meet & Little Magazine Fair which has been held during 19th-21st April and 24th to 25th May of 2022 respectively.

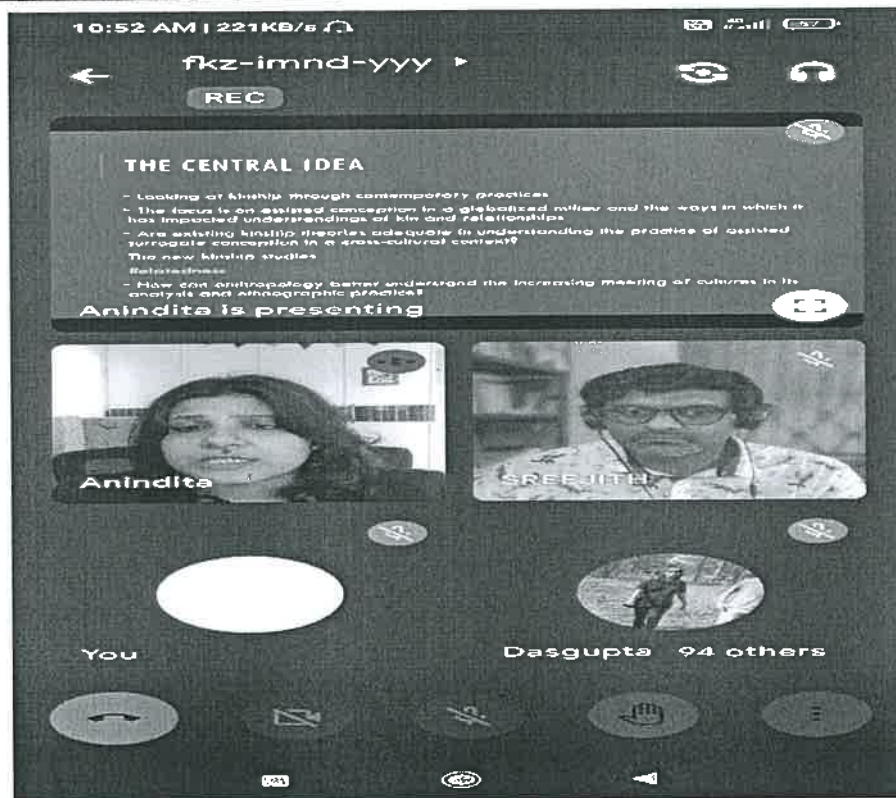
The vision of this exhibition was to promote the artists coming from different rural areas throughout the West Bengal and to encourage the people towards the folk arts of West Bengal. Honourable Vice-Chancellor of the Vidyasagar University Professor Sibaji Pratim Basu has inaugurated the programme on 5th April, 2022 and delivered his valuable speech on the significance and value of scroll-painting in Indian culture. Abed Chitrakar and his wife Sayra Chitrakar, two pata-artists from Chandipur has performed a "pater gan" for the University by singing pater gan with showing a scroll-painting which depicted the story of the ongoing exhibition and the role of the organising committee of the Vidyasagar University behind the whole programme. The products that has been exhibited and sold were mainly scroll-paintings, square patas and saris, t-shirts, kurtis, panjabis, wrappers, dopattas, trays, coasters, glasses, bottles, masks, kettles, lamps, paper weights etc. painted with patas on them. There are 10 stalls representing different art styles of patas of different areas. Anil Chitrakar and Sambhunath Chitrakar came from Bharatpur of Bankura district, Jamir Chitrakar came from Suri of Birbhum district, Abed Chitrakar, Sayra Chitrakar, Torap Chitrakar and Khukurani Chitrakar came from Hobichak, Chandipur of Purba Medinipur district, Shyamsundar Chitrakar and Rani Chitrakar came from Naya of Paschim Medinipur district whereas Baharjan Chitrakar came from Debra of Paschim Medinipur district. On 6th April in a session Abed Chitrakar has given a practical demonstration on making of natural colour used for the painting patas using flowers and the gum collected from the raw wood-apples. In another session on 7th April Abed Chitrakar, Sayra Chitrakar and Jamir Chitrakar has participated in the radio talk in "Betar Vidyasagar" radio station. Professor Monanjali Bandyopadhyay and Professor Sumahan Bandyopadhyay were the Chairperson and Convener of the committee respectively. Hon'ble Vice-chancellor appreciated their efforts in this regard.

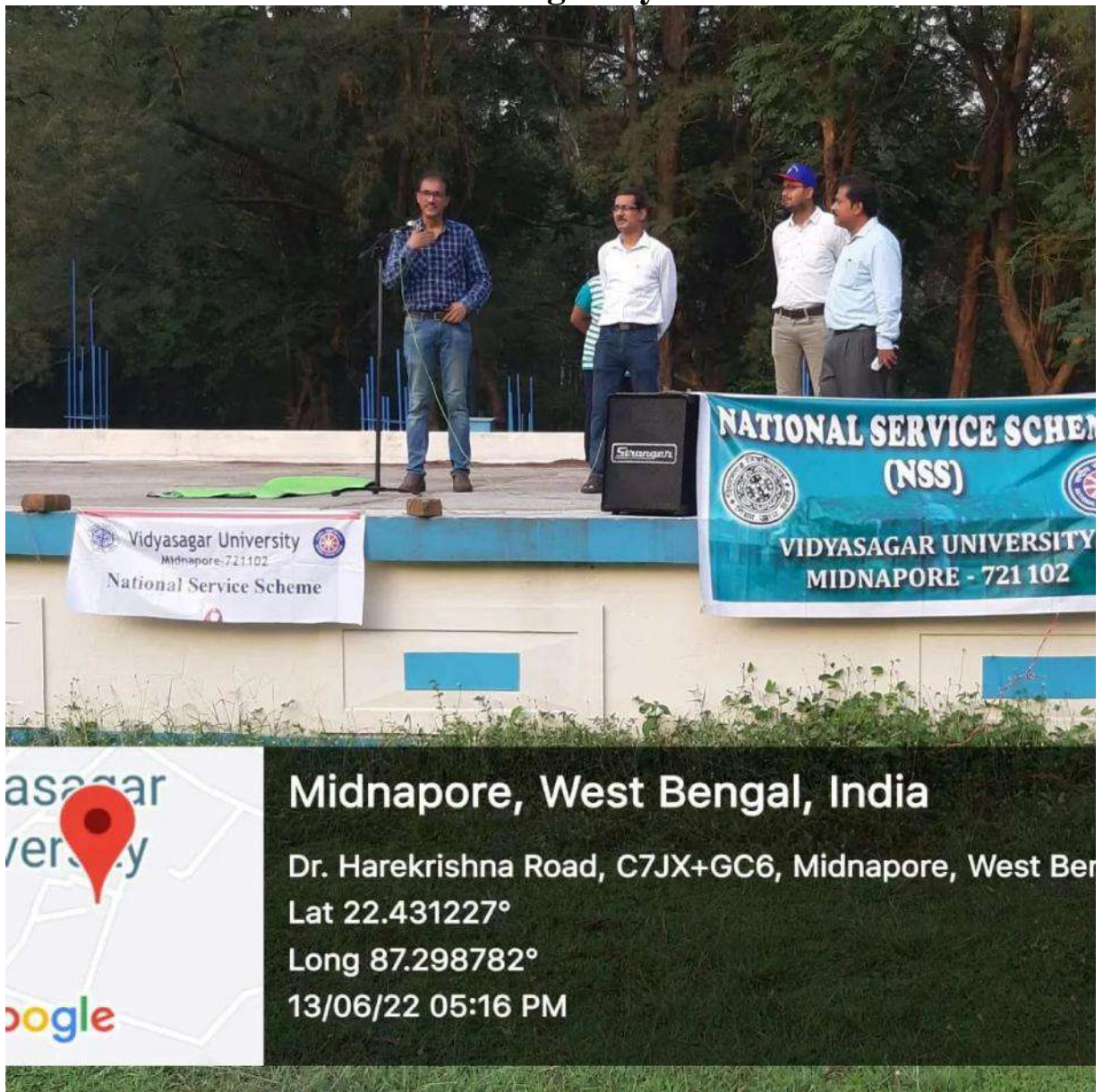




Figure: Programme on Yoga Week celebration on 13-19 June, 2022.
